FUNDRAISING PAGES



INDIVIDUALS who register a fundraiser get an individual fundraising page to track personal gifts and donations made on their behalf.

TEAM FUNDRAISERS will have a collective team fundraising page, PLUS, individual fundraising pages for each registered team member.

FUNDRAISING EXAMPLES

INDIVIDUAL FUNDRAISING

Franny registered as an INDIVIDUAL FUNDRAISER with a \$2,000 fundraising goal.

To accomplish her goal, Franny organizes her individual fundraiser for the year around several key moments when she will raise funds by tapping into her existing network.



TEAM FUNDRAISING

Franny teams up with Amy & Sally to fundraise in memory of a mutual friend who passed away from breast cancer.

Franny (team captain) starts a TEAM FUNDRAISER and invites Amy & Sally to join her "Pink Ladies" team.

> Throughout the year, all 3 team members raise money for their own individual fundraisers supported by friends and family.

Then, in November, they work together to host BINGO NIGHT, a fundraising event in their community benefiting the Foundation. As a team, they plan & promote the event, raising money with ticket sales and a silent auction. They submit a single check reflecting all of the proceeds from the event.
